We want to thank our Lake Hiawatha parent community for your help and cooperation in ensuring that the first month of school was a smooth transition for your children! Please find some notes below for our in-person students and remote learners:

1. *Please fill out the COVID screening form before 8:40AM each day* that your child attends school in-person. It helps us ensure a seamless transition into the classroom when the students arrive at school.
2. Please enter your child's absence for the day or the afternoon in the Genesis Parent Portal.
3. If your child isn't feeling well, please keep him/her at home. Given our current circumstances, we would sincerely appreciate parents being extra cautious to ensure the health and well-being of students and staff in the classroom.
4. All students who are learning from home must log into Seesaw or Google Classroom by 9am (1pm for PM Preschool) each day to access their daily schedule, including links to live instruction with teachers and classwork assignments. Logging in on time is compulsory for attendance.
5. Not logging in on time will count as an absence or tardy if you are late for your Google Meet.
